On the heels of Credit Education month, the Decatur Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will host a Credit Education Forum to provide resources and methods on improving credit scores, credit building tips, how identity theft affects credit scores, along with other topics related to personal credit scores.

In partnership with the Equifax BOLD (Blacks Organizing for Leveraging Differences) and On the Rise Community Development Center (Atlanta Builds Credit) organizations, the Credit Education Forum seeks to assist those who are just beginning to build their credit to those who need to improve or consider ways to repair their credit scores.

The Credit Education presentation by BOLD begins at 6:30 p.m. On the Rise will offer up to 20 personal credit coaching sessions to those who register beginning at 5:30 p.m. Credit Coaches will help registrants review (a) what has affected their credit scores; (b) ways to build, improve and raise their credit score; and (c) discuss safe credit building options.

At 5:30 p.m. registrants will be able to speak with Equifax representatives, network with session participants, enjoy refreshments, participate in raffles, and attend pre-scheduled credit coaching sessions. Everyone is asked to arrive by 6:15 p.m. for check-in and seating.
